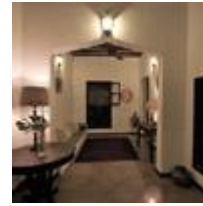


# KISIWA HOUSE Stone Town, Zanzibar

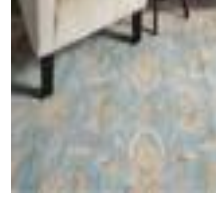
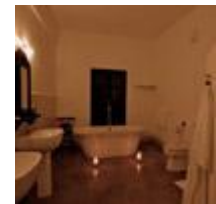
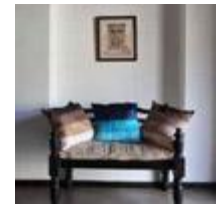


### ACCOMMODATION

#### Unit of Currency:

Tanzania Schilling, US Dollar & Euro.

#### Language:

Kiswahili is the national language. English is the official language.

#### Weather:

From June till September the weather is perfect with very low levels of rainfall and an average temp. of around 25°C. From Oct. till Dec. generally humid with short rains and temperatures rising into the 30s. In Jan. and Feb. it is warmer and the humidity remains high. From March till May it is the monsoon season with heavy downpours followed by glorious sunshine.
