Location

Dar es Salaam is located in a quiet bay off the Indian Ocean coast, on the Eastern coastline of Tanzania.

Dar es Salaam is a tropical climate with a wet and a dry season. January is the hottest month, while the coldest is July. September experiences the most daily sunshine hours (10) and April is the wettest month with an average of 240mm of rain.
